Cambodia has endured decades of violence, corruption, and suffering, including genocide at the hands of a hostile, radical communist movement called the Khmer Rouge in the 1970's that claimed the lives of roughly 2 million people. The people of Cambodia have shown great resilience in rebuilding their country since the defeat of the Khmer Rouge in 1975 but there's still much work to be done. Since 2013, GSC's dedicated volunteers have been offering assistance to help the Cambodian people acquire the training and skills to improve their lives, rebuild their civil society, and overcome these tragic chapters in its history.
